California State University, Fresno President John D. Welty pledged to increase the number of quality mathematics and science teachers prepared at the university as part of a nationwide Science and Mathematics Teacher Imperative.

The university is one of 121 public research universities involved in the program, 41 of which joined in a letter Jan. 6 to President Obama, pledging their institutions to train 10,000 math and science teachers by 2015.

The imperative reflects the goals of President Obama's Educate to Innovate campaign to elevate science and mathematics education in order to make the U.S. more competitive in the world.
